Early Christian Education class:

4 to 7 years. During church services Old and New Testament Bible stories, scripture, songs, and activity.

Tween's Christian Education class:

8 to 12 years. During church services. The Lord's Prayer, Bible verses, and the 10 Commandments.

Confirmation Class: 13 and 14 years.

Taught by Pastor Jim, preparation for Baptism, Confirmation and Communion. In-depth study of Christ's life and love. Developing a personal relationship with Christ. Bi-monthly in evening.

Youth Group: 15+ years. Evening group meetings by Pastor Jim and his wife Kim. Focus on Christ as personal savior, study, mission, and service.
