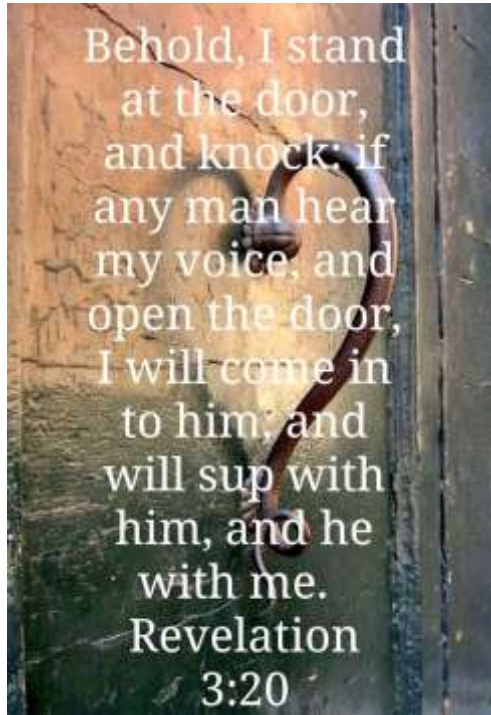

The Church Bulletin in your hands

Most churches in the United Methodist Church include a bulletin as an aid to the worship service. The bulletin designed as a guide in the order of the service, and how to participate. It is also intended to remind us of this week's scripture text, and to call everyone to worship on this week's theme. The unison prayer, is not only part of the service, but also for individual prayer and reflection during the upcoming week. **UMH** stands for the United Methodist Hymnal, which is in the pew rack in front of you. The page number following the scripture text is from the pew Bible in front of you, if you would like to follow along with the reading. Some find it helpful to mark the hymns and readings in advance. **Bold texts** in the call to worship, unison prayer, and Sunday school parade, are sections where the congregation speaks or sings in unison. **Asterisk** marks indicate the congregation standing together in body and/or spirit. We rejoice that you are worshipping together with us today, and pray that you will find the service meaningful and a blessing.




