He said something like this: "So much of the time we think about what we can give up for Lent. How about if we think about things that we normally don't do, and make an effort to do those things during lent?"

So, I encourage you to think of what these things might be. Here are a few possible ideas:

Maybe you don't have a regular prayer time. How about planning one for Lent?

Maybe you don't have a regular devotional time. You are welcome to a copy of a daily devotional called 'The Upper Room' at the back table and in the chapel. It has been a guide and help to many people in our congregation.

You might decide to share your faith with one other person at least once a week.

What are the things that can bring me into a closer, more meaningful relationship with Him?

May this season of Lent be a time of drawing closer, feeling and experiencing His presence, and of Him drawing closer to you.


